We're backing our lifesavers with the equipment they need to save lives

Thousands of volunteer surf life savers invest their time to patrol our coastline to keep the community safe.

That's why we're investing in them with \$23 million to deliver the equipment they need to save lives, position emergency management staff in the regions, boost radio communications on the North and South Coasts and better monitor unpatrolled areas.

It represents the biggest investment of any state government to Surf Life Saving NSW in its 116-year history and will better position it to keep people safe.

We'll also put a further \$5 million into upgrading local surf clubs, allowing dozens more clubs to improve these community hubs and drive up participation.

The Nationals in Government will...

Deliver a record funding boost to Surf Life Saving to invest in:

- 22 new rescue vehicles and 68 jet skis which can also be deployed during natural disasters like floods
- 40 additional emergency response beacons to help lifesavers remotely monitor unpatrolled areas
- Additional emergency management staff in the regions
- Radio communications upgrades on the North and South Coasts
